Key build milestone achieved

On 25 September, the Waitsia Gas Project Stage 2 team hit a significant project milestone with the installation of the huge, 28 meter, ~270 tonne CO₂ Absorber pressure vessel.

The install is the heaviest lift for the project, involving both the 650T crane and 275T tailing crane.

Once the gas plant is up and running, the job of the CO₂ Absorber is to remove CO₂ from the natural gas, which MEPAU will offset.


